

Hydrographic Survey

The navigational safety within the port is enhanced by dissemination of up to date hydrographical information to relevant port users. To this end, the Port of Sunderland will:

- Undertake hydrographic surveys within the port to establish the safe and efficient navigational channel.
- Undertake a schedule of hydrographic surveys of the channels and berths of the harbour.
- Provide up to date accurate hydrographic information, where appropriate, for port users.
- Maintain hydrographic records.
- Provide continuous, timely and accurate tidal data.
- Set and maintain programmes, standards and specifications for the port's hydrographic services.
- Maintain close liaison with, and provide relevant data, to the United Kingdom Hydrographic Office (UKHO).
